



Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to announce that Sports Day for Years 3-6 will be held at Mile End Stadium on Monday 19th May 2025. Further information regarding our EYFS and KS1 Sports Days will be shared with you at a later date.

All children from Year 3-6 will take part in a variety of athletic events throughout the day. Children will need to arrive at school in appropriate clothing e.g. trainers, leggings, tracksuit bottoms or shorts. Each class will travel to Mile End Stadium by walking with their class. We will be at the Stadium until 2.15pm, and children will be provided with a packed lunch for the day. Parents will be asked to leave the Stadium around 2.15pm, and children will walk back to school ready for the usual collection time of 3.30pm.

Location: Mile End Stadium

Travel: Walking

Clothing and Kit: Suitable clothing and trainers and an empty backpack to carry their lunch and water in. Please also ensure children have put sun cream on at home and provide a hat if the weather is warm.

Lunch: Packed lunches will be provided by the school.

The day will be broken down into two parts, a carousel of activities will take place from **9:50am – 11.30am** and a second carousel will take place from **12.30pm - 2.15pm**.

Parents can choose which carousel they would like to attend and if you wish you can choose to watch both carousels. Children will have lunch at 11:30am and we would kindly ask parents who have attended the morning carousel to vacate the premises at this point to allow for the second carousel of activities to be set up. Parent and Staff events will be taking place at the end of the afternoon carousel for all the parents who are keen to take part.

How to get there?

Parents should come to Mile End Stadium via the entrance near Rhodeswell Road. Parents will be able to view the morning events on the track from a safe viewing distance. The afternoon events will require use of the track and parts of the pitch and so parents will be able to view these events from allocated spaces in the grounds.



We will have members of staff at the entrance to the Stadium on Rhodeswell Road to direct you to the parents' spectating area. We understand that parents may want to take photographs of their children participating in Sports Day; as with all school events, we ask parents to only take photos of their own child, and not to share any photos with others including on social media, as per our safeguarding policies.
